

Hoops for Hope is a 3v3 tournament to benefit the Washington School for Girls, an all-scholarship independent school.

The Washington School for Girls (WSG) ignites the joyful pursuit of learning and inspires lives of faith-filled purpose, leadership, and service.

WSG is an all-scholarship independent Catholic school educating students in grades 3-8. Located in Ward 8 and serving the surrounding communities, the school provides an excellent academic program in a supportive environment which engages families and the community in the social, emotional, and spiritual growth of its students and graduates.

We help our students to become the confident, capable, and courageous young women they are meant to be. We do this by offering small classes, dedicated academic and family support, enrichment and technology for all students. Because WSG is deeply committed to educational equity, we have rooted our school in a community that has fewer independent school options, and every student who is admitted to WSG receives a full scholarship to attend.

WSG does not receive a per-student allocation from the government (like Charter or Public schools do), or the Archdiocese of Washington. Because we are not charging families tuition, the vast majority of our operating revenue comes from philanthropy.

The first Hoops for Hope tournament took place in 2012, and since then the annual event has raised over \$90,000 to support students at WSG thanks to the generous efforts of the Washington, DC business community. After a pandemic hiatus, the Auxiliary Board is excited to relaunch this successful event and expand it's reach into more companies and industries.
